TAG DER CLUBKULTUR was launched in 2020 by the Clubcommission on the initiative of the Senate Department for Culture and Europe and the Musicboard, and will once again honor the diversity of Berlin's club culture and the special commitment of the Berlin scene. An associated prize will award a total of 40 clubs and collectives in the city with 10,000 euros each. This offers the applicants an opportunity to reflect on their contribution to Berlin club culture during the past year and to help shape the club culture of tomorrow. With TAG DER CLUBKULTUR on October 3, a showcase festival will once again take place, during which Berlin's diverse club culture will present itself at numerous locations with its own events in the city.

All Berlin clubs and collectives can apply for the award in the context of the TAG DER CLUBKULTUR. This year's award focuses on two main themes: bridging the pandemic and visions for the future of Berlin club culture.

Since the pandemic poses an existential threat to Berlin's club culture on many levels, the creativity and commitment of clubs and collectives are essential. Many have managed not only to survive in difficult times, but to make an important social contribution and support their communities. Whether alternative concepts for the use of venues, collaborations with other cultural-political actors, strategies for the ongoing employment of staff or virtual community events, Berlin's club culture has been permanently in a state of flux in recent months and remains resistant and in solidarity.

Once again this year, general criteria will be part of the evaluation process of the submissions. These include the artistic and programmatic profile, the significance of the club or collective for Berlin club culture, awareness,

diversity and anti-discrimination, ecological sustainability, promotion of young talent, contribution to international dialogue, and solidarity with employees and others.

An independent, five-member board of trustees, representing the diversity of the Berlin club scene, decides on the awards for TAG DER CLUBKULTUR. This year, the board of trustees consists of DJ Gigola, Lewamm "Lu" Ghebremariam, Pansy, Volkan Ağar and Whitney Wei.

Clubs and collectives apply independently for the award of TAG DER CLUBKULTUR. The application documents to be sent in contain a short introduction of the club or collective as well as an examination of the above-mentioned general topics. There are no creative limits to the form of the submission. Further information can be found in the terms & conditions.
